2.0 - Agenda Amendments

 Directors Schwanbeck and Winter talked about the benefits of a

 stand alone fire district and what would be needed for such action.
- Update ad hoc committee consolidation Anderson/Shults

 Directors Anderson and Shults talked about the possible problems

 with a dissolution of the district but also identified it as a good

 probable secondary option.
- Resolution to adopt parcel tax measure special election winter

 Director Winter discussed the process to adopt a parcel tax measure to

 provide for future funding for the District. Action None

- **Discussion on possible contract for strategic plan drafting winter**Director Winter discussed several companies that could provide a

- 6.5 Discussion / update possible PERS funding options Blum Chief Blum discussed possible PERS funding options and stated that he had been in contact with one company who stated that it may be difficult for the District to fund a buyout without showing a successful parcel tax measure or showing three years of positive operational carry over.
- 6.6 Discussion FY26 budget adoption timeline Blum Chief Blum discussed the timeline to adopt the FY25/26 budget. He also stated his intent to perform a budget review and adjustment as some of the numbers allocated by the former Fire Chief did not make sense given our budgetary constraints.

Chief Blum asked the board if there were any standardized requests or things that they would like to see change with the Board Packets. He expressed his desire to produce a standardized packet moving forward. Director Anderson stated that he would like to see "Directors Reports" added back to the agendas.

 Director Schwanbeck provided an update on the status of the outstanding PRA requests.
- 6.9 Discussion on future release of call response statistics Blum
 Chief Blum discussed the challenge of releasing monthly call statistics but
 stated that the extra work would be worth it given the ability to show the
 community how the Firefighters were presently performing. The Chief also

stated that he hoped to change the statistics to match the NFPA 1720 standard not the present NFPA 1710 standard.

6.10 - Discussion on existing status of tower lease options - Anderson Director Anderson discussed the possibility of still entering into a contract for a tower lease. Director Anderson also stated he had received correspondence from other companies that have shown interest in leasing the tower. Action - None
