SECTION: 2100 SAFETY

SUBJECT: RESPIRATORY PROTECTION

PURPOSE: To ensure the safety of personnel who may in the course of their

involvement, be subject to a variety of hazardous atmospheres, be trained in the the need, use, sanitary care, and limitations of such respiratory equipment as any person may have the occasion to use...

SCOPE: Applies to all Felton Fire Protection District personnel.

PROCEDURE:

1. All Fire District personnel will not enter a contaminated atmosphere, or an atmosphere with the potential of becoming contaminated, without donning a Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus.

- 2. All Fire District personnel shall be trained in the need, use, and sanitary care of the District's S.C.B.A.'s.
- 3. All District personnel shall be able to don the S.C.B.A. within a time span of 60 seconds in accordance with current District training practices.
- 4. Every firefighter with this District shall be able to safely don the Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus within a time span of 60 seconds in accordance with current District training practices.
