**SUBJECT: FIREFIGHTER RESPONSE OUTSIDE THE FFPD
BOUNDARIES**

PURPOSE: To provide guidelines for fire fighters who may render assistance outside the jurisdiction of the Felton Fire Protection District.

SCOPE: This procedure shall be adhered to by all District personnel.

PROCEDURE:

1. District fire fighters shall proceed to and engage in emergency activities as directed or authorized by the Fire Chief pursuant to requests for Mutual Aid and as specified by the District's procedures for response to requests for mutual aid.
2. Operational guidelines for mutual aid can be found in these Standard Operating procedures and the Santa Cruz County Fire Agencies Operations Manual.
3. No District fire fighters shall respond to, or engage in emergency activities, or utilize district equipment in such activities without authorization as outlined in these Standard Operating Procedures.
4. All District fire fighters who respond to or engage in emergency activities in response to Mutual and/or Automatic Aid requests in violation of this procedure shall be considered to be acting beyond the scope of duties of the Felton Fire Protection District.
